This is a very sad story of 8-year-old Victoria Stafford who was kidnapped, tortured and murdered by two very evil, troubled people. Author Kelly Banaski did an excellent job telling this story. This is another excellent read from the Crimes Canada Series and I highly recommend it.

Taking Tori is one hell of a good true crime read. The author worked hard to get an interview with one of Tori's killers. It was Terri-Lynne's first interview and from what I've gleaned about her

personality, I'd bet it was her last. So this will be your only chance to get the inside scoop on what was really going on in the killer's mind that day. Be sure you want to though, because as with all true crime books that have exclusive info, that depth of detail makes the story more jarring. It will stay with you for a while. Banaski has taken one of the most horrifying crimes in the annals of Canada's history and managed to give us an outstanding account of it. Skillfully she draws us into the case, provides all the background on the killers that we need to know, answers all questions and leaves us feeling well sated that we have the full story. Highly recommend it to true crime fans!
