

Practice test that is structured like the National Board Dental Hygiene Examination simulates actual experience of taking boards. Sources for chapters listed at end of every chapter provide resources that will reflect current theory, practice standards, and research findings. New chapter on General Anatomy gives an overview of the body's structure and function for a better understanding of how problems in one body system can affect the rest of the body. Added chapter on General Pathology describes disease development and includes a discussion on the process of inflammation and the genetic basis of disease. Full-color design shows greater detail in photos and illustrations for more comprehensive learning. Detailed information on legal/ethical/safety issues incorporated throughout shows how these issues can fit into their everyday practice, rather than thinking of them as separate elements of hygiene practice. Listings of websites within chapters offer current information on important developments in dental hygiene topics. New chapter review questions at the end of most chapters.

The Internet resources provided in the text allow students to gather additional relevant information on a wide range of topics important to dental hygienists.
