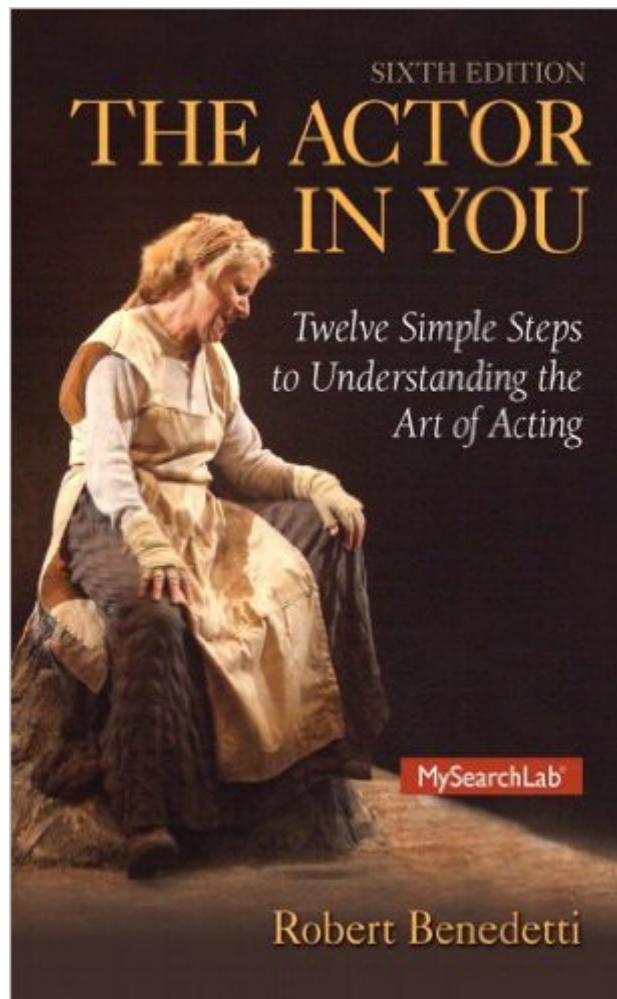

Robert Benedetti is one of the most respected teachers of the art of acting in America today. In *The Actor in You*, Benedetti lays out 16 lessons describing the theory in understandable terms, exercises the reader can do to enhance his or her acting skills, and, especially the second edition, several useful skits and portions of plays to illustrate the principles. I have used this book as a text while teaching Acting at the college level and highly recommend it.
