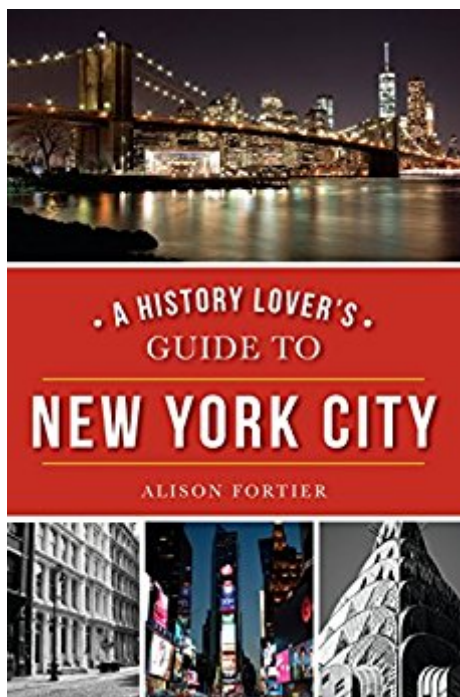

Ms. Fortier presents a coherent, albeit brief, history of one of the world's great cities, as it evolved over more than 400 years. In fourteen chapters, each with a story emphasizing one historical dimension of New York, the reader is introduced to people, places, and events that define New York City and its place in American culture and history. The author takes the reader to hundreds of sites, some familiar and iconic and others more obscure, locating each in a larger historical context. Along

the way we encounter explorers and great political figures (such as Verrazano and Washington), conspicuous consumers from the gilded age (such as Rockefeller and Vanderbilt), builders and inventors (such as Roebling and Edison) and even PT Barnum's circus elephant, Jumbo. Ms. Fortier wisely leaves dining and lodging to others. A History Lovers Guide to New York City enriches the New York experience by identifying important historical themes and linking them to seemingly disparate sites. This guide offers an accessible history to anyone interested in this great city and can be an essential resource for parents and teachers organizing excursions to Gotham.
