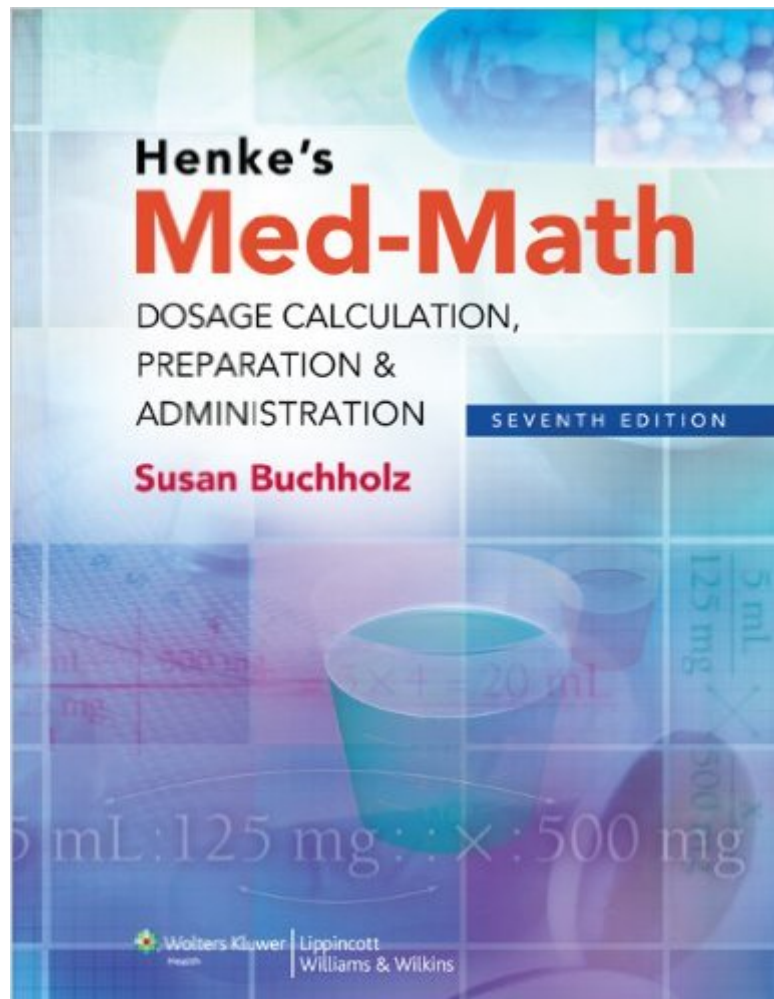

The solutions are shown in two formats: Proportional and Dimensional Analysis. I do enjoy that it includes a plastic pocket units/formula guide.
